

## **ROCKAWAY TOWNSHIP FREE PUBLIC LIBRARY**

The mission of the Rockaway Township Free Public Library is to ensure that all people of Rockaway Township have free and open access to information and ideas. In keeping with this mission and as a public service, the library provides space for the posting of announcements and the distribution of leaflets and other printed material not generated by the library itself. This space is available to organizations of a civic, cultural, educational or recreational nature.

The intent is to give access to as much community information as possible. The library does not endorse and is not responsible for the views expressed in any of the material to be distributed or posted. The existence of a particular viewpoint in an exhibit, leaflet or posting is an expression of the library's policy on intellectual freedom, not an endorsement of a particular point of view. In order to avoid the appearance of an endorsement, the library will not post notices of partisan, political, religious or commercial events or activities.

The use of the Community bulletin board is free of charge. Posting of notices is limited to available space. Appearance and content of notices must be suitable for display in a public service area. Notices will be displayed for as long as they are current, up to four weeks. Display materials are considered disposable and library staff may remove and discard as necessary.
