(2010, Not Rated, 80 mins.)

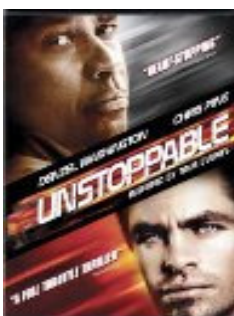
